

Sunday Sounds Special Concert Series at the Hingham Public Library

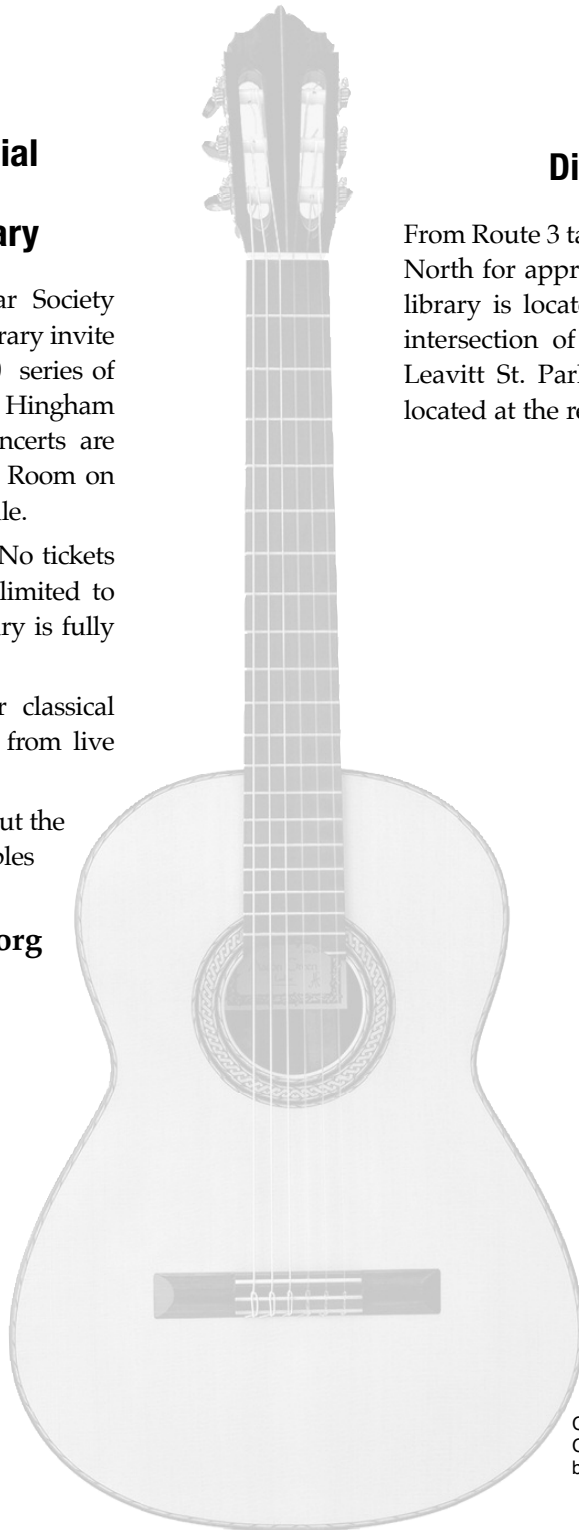
