HINGHAM PUBLIC LIBRARY MUSEUM PASS POLICY

Hingham residents with library privileges may reserve passes up to 60 days in advance. Residents from other towns may request passes after 5 PM prior to the day of intended use.

Reservations may be made in person, by phone, or online at www.hinghamlibrary.org.

All passes are checked out at the library's reference desk.

A \$2.00 user fee is charged for each pass except the Science Museum, Aquarium, Gardner, Hall at Patriot Place, USS Constitution, World's End, & Boston Harbor Islands.

Replacement fees for lost passes vary between \$10 and \$25, according to individual pass policy.

Cancellations should be made as far in advance as possible by notifying the library reference desk.

Failure to cancel will incur a \$2 user fee. Patrons who repeatedly fail to cancel are subject to having subsequent reservations denied.

Patriot Place pass must be returned by 9 AM on day after use. Other returnable passes are due by noon on the day after use.

Repeated failure to return passes on time will result in suspension of pass borrowing privileges.

Passes returned late incur a \$3.00 per day overdue fine.

PASSES AVAILABLE

Boston by Foot (May-Oct.) – Free admission, 4 people

Boston Harbor Islands (May-Oct.) – Buy one ticket, get one free: limit of 2 free passes.

Children's Museum – Reduced admission, ½ price regular admission, 4 people

Edward M. Kennedy Institute – Reduced admission, \$7 per person, 2 people

Gardner Museum – Reduced admission, \$5 per person, 4 people

Heritage Museums & Gardens (April-Oct.) – Reduced admission, ½ price regular admission, 2 adults & 4 children

Harvard Museum of Natural History - Reduced admission, \$6 per person, 4 people

Hall at Patriot Place – Free admission, 4 people

Institute of Contemporary Art - Reduced admission, \$5 per person, 2 people

Kennedy Library – Reduced admission, \$3 per person, 2 people

Museum of Fine Arts – Reduced admission, \$10 per person, 2 people

Museum of Science – Reduced admission, \$10 per person, 4 people

New England Aquarium - Reduced admission, \$10 per person, 4 people (Sept.-June)

Peabody Essex Museum – Reduced admission, \$5 per person weekdays, \$10 per person weekends and holidays, 2 adults (Youth under 16 are free)

Plimoth Plantation (Apr-Nov) – Reduced admission, \$12, 4 people

USS Constitution – Free admission, up to 9 people

World's End - Free admission, 1 family

Zoo New England (Franklin Park & Stone Zoo) - Reduced admission, 6 people at \$9 per adult and \$6 per child
