And One For All

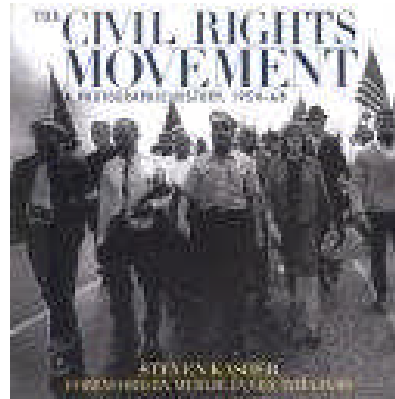
